

WAYNE FINGER LAKES YOUTH SOCCER LEAGUE
COACHES CHECK LIST

The HOME coach is required to call or email the opposing coach prior to the scheduled game, preferably a couple of days before you are scheduled to play. You need to verify the team colors of each team and if a conflict, the home team will make the change. Also you need to verify that the opposing coach knows where and how to get to your field. A 30 minute grace period is allowed after the scheduled kick off.

Where are my player passes?

Where is my Coaches RISK MANAGEMENT PASS?

NO PASSES, NO PLAY!

You will have 30 minutes to produce your team's passes after the scheduled kick off. Still no passes. Game is declared a forfeit. Sorry, too much at stake here to play without them.

Did I fill out my Team Roster/Game Report Form correctly?

It is NOW official. EVERY coach MUST fill out the Team Roster/Game Report by using a computer. This form was created in Excel (.xls) and the information required is easily inputted. Hand written forms will not be accepted. A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for each incorrect form. Form can be found on www.wflysl.com

Fill in all of these sections:

- ✓ TEAM ROSTER FOR:
- ✓ List all of your players including your secondary players that are playing up on your team. Include jersey No. and Player NYSWest I.D. #. The day of your game cross out the players that are not playing that day. Remember you may play 22 players max for U13, 15, & 18 and 18 players max for U11. If you have more than 22 or 18 on your game report you MUST cross off players as you can not play anymore that 22 or 18 per game
- ✓ Game No., Kick-Off, Game Date, Age Division
- ✓ Field Location and HOME TEAM

Both Home and Away Coaches are required to have two copies of your Team Roster/Game Report Forms at every game. The HOME Coach will also provide the referee a self addressed, self stamped envelope with Becca Klejment's address for Girls & Jamie Carr's address for Boys on it along with the required game fee.

PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO EXTREMELY HIGH TEMPERATURES THAT MAY OCCUR DURING SUMMER PLAY, 90+ DEGREES, A DECISION BETWEEN BOTH COACHES AND THE REFEREE WILL DETERMINE THE LENGTH OF PLAY FOR THE GAME TO BE PLAYED.

EITHER PLAY 4 EQUAL QUARTERS OR REDUCE THE LENGTH OF TIME FOR EACH HALF OF PLAY. THIS IS A COMMON SENSE DECISION THAT HAS ONLY THE SAFETY OF THE PLAYERS IN MIND. PLEASE IMPLEMENT THIS ACTION AS NEEDED! THANK YOU.

The HOME Coach will provide the referee with (3) game balls and (2) ball persons

Each coach will provide the referee with a linesman. This is typically a parent or sibling of a player.

The only responsibility of the linesman is to flag when the ball is out of bounds.

Each coach is required to hand out the player passes to each player before the referee speaks with them.

Each coach (or team rep) will sign the Team Roster/Game Report at the end of the game. After signing the Team Roster/Game Report the referee will return your player passes. Please count them and make sure you do not leave the playing field without all of them.

If the official does not show up! Coaches must agree on a substitute. Pay them the game fee and Home coach must fill out Game Report and mail to appropriate Boys (Jamie Carr) or Girls (Becca Klejment) Age Division Coordinator. Please write in the space for Officials Name: "NO official showed up". Jamie or Becca will contact Randy Luke.

A reminder. Players and coaches on one side of the field and the fans on the opposite side.

A TEAM DOES NOT SHOW UP FOR SCHEDULED GAME.

If the HOME team does not show up your Referee must contact Randy Luke that night and he/she will be paid the entire game fee after forfeit is verified by the league.

If the VISITING team does not show up the Referee will fill out game report from the HOME coach and state on the report: Team xxx did not show up. Referee must mail the report that night to the league's respective Age Division Coordinator and contact Randy Luke that night and explain the situation.

REMINDER:

The Home Coach is required to call in scores within 24 hrs of playing the game.

The procedures to do this are as follows:

1. Dial the toll free number 1-866-334-6294.
2. When asked, say or enter the pin number of the league. Our code for the *WFLYSL Summer 2011* is **2238**.
3. Next you will say or enter the game number of the game just played.
4. You will then be told the division, teams playing, and field location - if this is the correct game, confirm by saying yes.
5. When asked, say or enter the score for each team, then confirm.
6. You can do more games in the same call, or just say goodbye when done.
